

WELCOME TO BADGER CLASS

Welcome back after summer holidays. I'm Mr King, the class teacher for Badger Class.

I'm very excited about a new start to the year. We've lots of exciting learning and activities planned in the first two terms alone.

Term 1 Topic: Alice in Wonderland / Potions

By reading Alice's Adventures in Wonderland, we'll learn all about fantasy worlds and mysterious potions, aromatic brews, vapour and sticky goo.

Our class will be looking at safety labels on chemicals and liquids and write our own safety labels for Alice's bottle.

Becoming super scientists, we'll investigate properties and changes of materials and explore chemical reactions and states of matter.

We will research the use of anaesthetic and learn what life was like without it!

We are studying the many poems in Alice in Wonderland and will write our own poems based on Jabberwocky.

The play, Romeo and Juliet will inspire us to write scripts, and we'll think of an alternative ending for this tragic tale. We'll write spells with magical, strange or gruesome effects – what ingredients will we use? It will be great fun to make chocolate hearts and bath bombs! We shall also create canvas art on a large scale!

At the end of the topic, the whole class will create our own potions and follow instructions to make delicious potion treats to share.

Term 2 Topic - Time Traveller

In term 2, we will meet people from different generations to find out what life was like in the past and we'll predict how things might change in the future.

Using real portraits from the past for inspiration, we'll write character descriptions about the people in them. In Art, we'll create a timeline of our lives and watch a time-lapse of human development.

By taking close-up photographs, we will create our own Andy Warhol style prints and experiment to see how photographs can be changed and enhanced. Smile, please!

Our book will be Tom's Midnight Garden and using this to write our own adventure stories about the fascinating subject of time travel.

Our science work will focus on puberty and why hygiene is important. We'll also create clock artwork based on the style of Salvador Dali.

At the end of the topic, we'll make collages to represent our hopes and dreams and create an electronic time capsule that represents life in the present day.
