





# PARKSIDE COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL


Dear Parents/Carers,

Our topic for Term 6 is 'The Scented Garden'. We will be learning all about gardens, plants and insects. We will make careful observations of plants so that we can draw them accurately. We will also be finding out all about bees and planting our outdoor garden to attract the bees.


In Science we are learning about Plants. We will be investigating to see what plants need to grow, finding out about the different parts of plants and working out their lifecycles. We hope to grow our own bean plants!



In English we will be reading stories about gardens – some of them magic! We will also be writing letters to help the mini-beasts sort litter problems and writing an information sheet to show all our learning about insects. Homework will be sent home once a week for English. Once again, could we encourage you to listen to your child read – it's very exciting to see how they have progressed.



In Maths we are learning all about multiplication and division. The children will also be reviewing their learning about fractions. They are becoming very good 'maths detectives' – solving lots of maths problems and we will continue with this too this term. They are making excellent progress with their Next Steps Maths.
