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Dear Parents and Carers,

You will find the links to these lessons in the emails sent from the class teacher.

The following important points will ensure that the Zoom lessons run as smoothly as possible and your child gets the most from them.

- Join the meeting five minutes early if possible so teachers can register the class.
- Name the device your child is using with their full name so their identity can be confirmed as quickly as possible. Those devices that cannot be identified will not be allowed access to the lesson. If you have difficulty with this, please email your child's class teacher.
- Please make sure that your child is suitable dressed to attend the session and set the right format for a constructive learning environment.
- Continue to send in work via email to share the wonderful learning with our teachers.
- Screenshots, photos or recordings of Zoom lessons must not be made and the links must not be shared with others.
- Participants may be removed from the lesson if rules are not being followed.

We know that many of you have been accessing home learning from a range of different devices such as computers, laptops, Macs, Chrome books, tablets, Ipads, Xboxes, Playstations and phones depending on your situation. We will be in contact with those families that have notified us of difficulties with accessing the home learning on a device soon. Parents and Carers may continue to collect paper work-packs of the home learning from school each week if they wish. Please contact your teacher if this is needed and to arrange a suitable time to collect from the school office.

We fully understand that many of you are able to commit different amounts of time to supporting your children at home with their learning as everyone's circumstances are different. We would like to thank all of you for as little or as much of the home learning as you are able to do at this difficult time. Don't forget that activities such as playing games, reading, baking or going for a walk will also help your children with their learning. Please do not worry - you are all doing a fantastic job!
