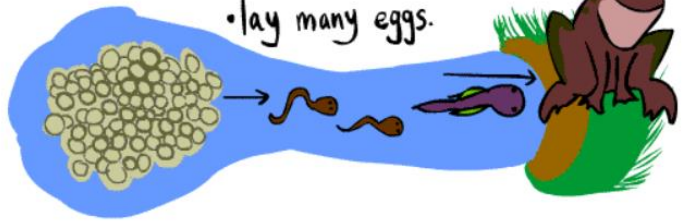


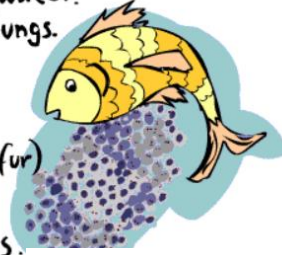
AMPHIBIANS

- live on land & in water.
- webbed feet.
- breathe with lungs & gills.
- Cold-blooded.
- moist smooth skin, (no hair or fur)
- 4 legs (sometimes none)
- lay many eggs.



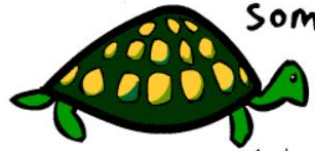
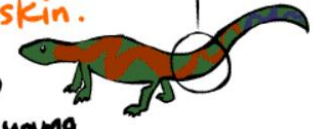
FISH

- breathe underwater using gills, not lungs.
- live in water
- have scales and fins. (no hair or fur)
- Cold-blooded.
- lay MANY eggs.



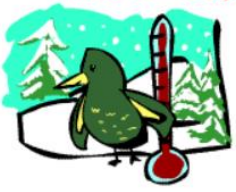
REPTILES

- have scales, not fur.
- have dry skin.
- usually lay eggs, sometimes live young
- ear holes instead of ears.
- 4 legs or no legs
- Cold-blooded.



BIRDS

- have feathers & wings
- lay eggs
- have 2 legs
- ear holes instead of ears.
- warm-blooded



MAMMALS

- have hair or fur
- give birth to live young?
- mammal mothers nurse their young with milk.
- have lungs and need air to breathe.
- mammals that live on land have 4 legs, and ears that stick out.
- warm-blooded
