We will be exploring the phenomenon that is our digestive system and will be carrying out experiments to see how our amazing bodies work as well as making rainstorm music and looking into the North and South of England. The children have had a brilliant start to the term and are already working incredibly hard in lessons and I can't wait for them to continue to show me how amazing they all are!

## <u>Term 5</u>

In term 4 our topic is The North and South of England where we will be looking at counties, compasses and weather.

In our English lessons, our first key text will be 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes which we will be using as inspiration for some amazing writing opportunities.

In maths, we will be continuing practicing our times tables and division facts while starting a new topic of decimals. I would like to take this time to remind you of our school's TT Rock Stars account where children have the chance to practice, play and challenge their friends and teachers. In science, we will be investigating the digestive system which offers lots of exciting opportunities for experiments and investigation.

## <u>Term 6</u>

Our new topic in term 6 is natural disasters which is a great topic with lots of engaging learning opportunities.

After half term, we will be looking at the texts, Disney Pixar's 'Lava' and some fiction from CPGs Volcano and Earthquakes study books.

In maths, our main focus will be decimals, but we will be gradually moving on to money and time. Again, please take advantage of TT Rockstars to help improve your children's times table recall, it is a fun and easy way to make maths enjoyable and easier for children to access.

For science, we will be looking at animals including humans in which we will explore the human teeth.



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Attendance: I would like to take this opportunity to remind you how important good attendance is for optimum learning and progress. At Parkside, we aim for 95% attendance or more to ensure our best possible learning is able to take place. It is also important that children arrive to school on time so they start their day in the best possible way and are ready to start their learning with the rest of their class.


#### Uniform:
