Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our learning about Castles in term 5, we have arranged a trip to The Tower of London on Wednesday 18th March. We will explore the tower, including the fabulous Crown Jewels and look at the building's history as a fortress, prison and palace as well as a home to many past Kings and Queens. We will also be taking part in workshops to enhance our knowledge of the past.

We will be travelling to and from London by coach and will leave school at 8.30am sharp. Please ensure that your child is in school for 8.10am for registration. We will leave London at 3pm to return to Parkside at 4.45pm (Please be prepared for this to change depending on traffic congestion and delays out of London so please regularly check for this on class Dojo). This is a fantastic learning opportunity for your child and I am sure they will have a wonderful day and learn a great deal about the history of the Royal Family and the Tower of London.

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing full school uniform, comfortable shoes and has a waterproof coat as we will be outside for large parts of the day. They will need a packed lunch and enough drink to last the day. The children will be carrying their lunches all day so please put it in a back pack or other suitable bag and ensure that it is not too heavy.

If your child is eligible for a free school meal and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch, please complete the slip below and return no later than the morning of Wednesday 11th March. Please ensure that lunches brought from home contain no nuts due to allergies.
