### TERMS 3 & 4

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to term 3, I would like to start by saying what a fantastic 2 terms I have had with the children. They have been hardworking, resilient and keen to learn. I am extremely proud of the achievements they have made so far and look forwards to rest of the year.

We start the New Year with Ancient Greece as our topic moving onto Modern Greece in term 4. During this term, we will be exploring the influences the Ancient Greeks have had on our everyday lives and the impact their inventions have made. In week 3, the children have a Greek WOW day where they will be making pottery, trying a variety of Greek inspired food and learning some famous Greek dance moves. We will be learning about Greek mythology and ending the term with a trip to Kent life to take part in a day of exciting Ancient Greek Workshops.

#### Term 3

In term 3 our English topic is Myths and Legends. The key text is ' Leo and the Gorgon's Curse' By Joe Todd – Standton and 'Who Let the Gods out?' by Maze Evans. The children will be creating and writing some mythical narrative stories as well as creating an advert for a new shop in Asphodel Fields, writing a care guide for a Cerberus and producing an information leaflet about a chosen mythical character. The term will end with a unit on poetry

In maths, we continue with multiplication and division where the children will learn their 3,4 and 8 times tables. We will be learning a variety of methods to support our reasoning and problem solving skills. We will also be looking at length and perimeter where the children will be measuring and converting in millimetres, centimetres and metres. We end the term with an introduction to fractions.

Our science lessons are focussing on 'Light and Dark' where we will be discovering where light sources come from, understanding how shadows are made and how light is reflected from different surfaces.

#### Term 4

In term 4, our English is based around non-fiction texts and writing units. We will be looking at life in Greece in the modern day. We will be exploring how to write persuasively through advertisement using a variety of media including leaflets, newspaper articles and posters.

In maths, the children will be focusing on fractions looking at different fractions and understanding the term numerator and denominator. They will be learning to count in fractions and order them on a scale. For the second half of the term, the children will be introduced to mass and capacity, they will be measuring mass in grams and kilograms as well as adding and subtracting mass. Finally, they will be measuring capacity in millilitres and litres.

In science, we will be learning about 'Animals Including Humans'. The children will be learning about nutrients and food groups, investigating both animal and human skeletons and looking at food chains. There are lots of practical activities during this topic and I know the children will enjoy making their own skeletons and moving muscles throughout the term.

**Attendance:** I would like to take this opportunity to remind you how important good attendance is for optimum learning and progress. At Parkside, we aim for 95% attendance or more to ensure our best possible learning is able to take place. It is also important that children arrive to school on time so they start their day in the best possible way and are ready to start their learning with the rest of their class.

**Uniform:**

This is a reminder that all children should be wearing the correct school uniform. This consists of: Parkside School jumper so children can take pride in our school logo (or a navy jumper/cardigan), a white shirt or blouse, grey/black trousers or a skirt (or shorts/summer dress when it is warmer) and black school shoes.
